

Nathaniel R. Greeley (1829-1924/5?)
Boscawen, N.H. and Penacook, N.H.

Account Books 1867-1912 17 vols.

Nathaniel R. Greeley was born in Boscawen, N.H. 10 June 1829 and married Emma S. Call of Webster, N.H. 14 June 1864. They had four children but only two lived to maturity, Leon and Leonora. Greeley is listed in the Concord City Directory (kind of business not given) as living at 127 North Main St., Pennacook (opposite the Academy).

The collection consists of personal household accounts, a bank book and records of patients and prescriptions or eye glass frames required. It is obvious from the sequence of dates that he traveled throughout New Hampshire and the border towns of Massachusetts and Vermont in order to serve his clients. There 3 miscellaneous accounts and 6 volumes of household accounts.

The collection was purchased in August 1797.
