Abstract:

This collection consists primarily of letters among a few women in the William Haseltine family written between 1850 and 1861. They relate news of family and friends, report on deaths of infants, hopes for living children, plans, and thanks for visits to come or finished. There are photographs, some identified, of family and friends, and early 19th century deeds for family property in Pembroke and Allenstown, NH.

Collection Overview

Biographical Information:

Although the surname is given as Hazelton in the published genealogy [Genealogical Sketches of Robert and John Hazelton, compiled by William B. Lapham, 1892], the family whose letters are in this collection appear to have spelled it Haseltine. Individuals from whom there are materials in the collection are in **bold.**

Letters in this collection center on relatives of William Haseltine (1809-1897) and his wife, Harriet (1828-1909). They married at Pembroke on September 6, 1854.

William (**1809-1897**) and Harriet M. Hazelton (1828-1909). William was class of 1835 at Dartmouth College, read law with Daniel Webster, and lived in Pembroke and Allenstown, NH.

They had:

Moses (1855-1858)

William Henry (1855-1890), married Mary Gage

Caroline Elizabeth (1857-1858)

Jennie (1859-1937), married Frank E. Blodgett

William Haseltine's parents and siblings were:

William Haseltine (1776-1864) and Nabby (Emery) Haseltine (1779-1867), who lived in Pembroke, NH. They had:

William (1806-1808)

Sally (1808-1842), never married

William (1809-1897), married **Harriet** Hazelton (1828-1909)

Caroline (1811-1842), never married

Hannah (1815-1915), never married

Abby (1815-1844), married Enoch Sherman

Moses (1817-1870), married Katherine Sherman

Mary (1824-1903), married Matthew Emery, moved to Washington, DC

Collection Scope and Content Note:

The Haseltine-Hazelton Family Papers consist of correspondence, business papers, photographs, deeds, and miscellaneous ephemera. Personal letters in this collection were written to Mary Haseltine Emery (1824-1903). Letters are from her brother William Haseltine (1809-1897), his wife Harriet (1828-1909), and her sister-in-law, Katherine Sherman Haseltine. They concern matters such as the deaths of babies, health of relatives and neighbors, and visits.

The collection also contains a few of William Haseltine's business records (receipts, bills) and Haseltine family deeds (1804-1850) for various properties in Pembroke and Allenstown, NH. Also included are two insurance policies: one on a public house near Suncook, NH, and one on a church vestry in Suncook.

There are two albums of photographs of family and friends (one intact, one disassembled), some but not all of which are identified. Few are dated.

Arrangement:

The materials in this collection are arranged alphabetically by family member. Letters are arranged alphabetically by writer. Business materials (receipts, bills, etc.) are arranged chronologically by the name of the recipient of the items. Deeds are arranged chronologically. Photographs are in as-found order. The bound photograph album is at the end of the collection.
