Abstract:

This collection consists of photographs taken by J. B. Warren, a photographer from Franklin, NH, who had a summer photography studio at "Blodgetts" [Blodgetts Landing] in Newbury, NH. The majority of images are of unidentified buildings, unidentified people, and of Sunapee Lake.

Collection Overview

Biographical Information:

James B. Warren was born on March 26, 1848 in Hill, NH, to Charles and Hannah (Tucker) Warren. Warren was a prominent photographer in Franklin, NH, who also had a summer studio at Blodgetts Landing in Newbury, NH. James married Anna Shaw on September 25, 1870 at Franklin, NH. She was born at Franklin on August 10, 1853, the daughter of Hiram and Sarah (Simonds) Shaw. James and Anna divorced on October 20, 1880. He died on November 11, 1910 in Franklin from cirrhosis of the liver, and his death record states he was adopted by Enoch Adams and Hannah Tucker.

Collection Scope and Content Note:

The J. B. Warren Photograph Collection, circa 1890 to 1910, contains photographs of building exteriors and interiors, groups of people, Sunapee Lake, individual portraits of people and a dog, cows, horses, dams, and railroads. Other than a few photographs labeled New London, NH, the majority of images contain no dates, nor identifying information on location or people. Most of the images are labeled either “Views and Groups a Specialty” or “During July and Aug. ‘Blodgetts’ Newbury, N.H.”
